

    - ◆ C.' Return of Nehemiah (Neh. 1—2)
  - B.' Building of the walls and opposition (Neh. 3:1—7:3)
- A.' Zerubbabel's return and list of returnees; final reforms (Neh. 7:4—13:31)

## Components of Nehemiah's Prayer

- Addressee is the LORD
- Praise
- Recognition of the LORD's character as a promise keeper
- Petition for the LORD to hear his prayer regarding the Israelites
- Confession of the corporate sin of Israel
- Reminder of the if->then promise given to Moses for Israel
- Reminder that the Israelites are the LORD's chosen people
- Petition to hear his prayer
- Asking for success by gaining favor from the king

- Address to the LORD
  - LORD, the God of Heaven (v5a)
- Praise
  - the great and awesome God (v5b)
- Recognition of the LORD's character as a promise keeper
  - who keeps his covenant of love with those who love him and keep his commandments (v5c)
- Petition for the LORD to hear his prayer regarding the Israelites
  - let your ear be attentive and your eyes open to hear the prayer your servant is praying before you day and night for your servants, the people of Israel (v6a)
- Confession of the corporate sin of Israel
  - I confess the sins we Israelites, including myself and my father's family, have committed against you. 7 We have acted very wickedly toward you. We have not obeyed the commands, decrees and laws you gave your servant Moses. (vv6b-7)
- Reminder of the if->then promise given to Moses for Israel
  - "Remember the instruction you gave your servant Moses, saying, 'If you are unfaithful, I will scatter you among the
    nations, 9 but if you return to me and obey my commands, then even if your exiled people are at the farthest horizon, I
    will gather them from there and bring them to the place I have chosen as a dwelling for my Name.' (v8)
- Reminder that the Israelites are the LORD's chosen people
  - They are your servants and your people, whom you redeemed by your great strength and your mighty hand (v10)
- Petition to hear his prayer
  - Lord, let your ear be attentive to the prayer of this your servant and to the prayer of your servants who delight in revering your name (v11a)
